

In an effort to address the ongoing challenges of delivering courses in this COVID-19 environment, The University of Akron will deliver fall courses through a variety of formats, including in-person, online and hybrid. You should have already received announcements regarding schedule adjustments via Zipmail, but below is an overview of the variety of course delivery formats you may see on your schedule. Please note that the majority of schedule changes were completed in mid-July, but further adjustments may occur due to room capacity, instructor availability and COVID-19 conditions. Please make sure to check your schedule frequently so you do not miss any changes. The fall semester begins on Monday, August 24.

Final two weeks will be online

Classes and exams will move online for the last two weeks of the fall semester. In-Person instruction will end for the fall semester at 4 p.m. on Wednesday, Nov. 25, and the final week of instruction and the exam week will be conducted remotely. The move online will reduce travel to and from campus after Thanksgiving break, further lowering the risk of COVID-19 infection.

Viewing Your Schedule in MyAkron



To view your fall schedule, please login to MyAkron and select the Student Center icon. To login to your MyAkron account, simply visit <https://my.uakron.edu>. You will need to enter your UANet ID and password to login. If you have forgotten your password or it has expired, please call the IT Help Desk at 330-972-6888. Select the option for login support.

When you go to Student Center to view your schedule, you should look for two pieces of information: WHEN and WHERE. These are listed for each class in the Schedule column on the main page in the Student Center.

Below are detailed descriptions of the different course delivery types.



ONLINE (ASYNCHRONOUS)

WHEN: You'll see no days or times. This means your course doesn't require real-time meetings. You can watch lectures and complete assignments on your own time, but remember to pay attention to due dates and deadlines.

WHERE: You'll see "www site," which means the location of your class is online. You will be able to access the class in Brightspace at the start of the semester.

HYBRID TESTING

DISTANCE LEARNING CLASSES

Since some of the area schools now have later start dates or alternative schedules, distance learning classes will now be instructed in the **ONLINE LIVE (SYNCHRONOUS)** format using Webex video-conferencing technology. This will allow students to participate in the class on a PC, laptop, tablet or even a smartphone by downloading the Webex app, so you do not have to be at the school in the distance learning classroom. Some classes have also changed to the **ONLINE (ASYNCHRONOUS)** format, so please review your schedule. Distance Learning classes will still begin the week of August 24, but the change in format will give you the flexibility to attend from anywhere, especially if your school will have a later start.
