# Rules for the WAYNE COLLEGE Student Writing Awards

These writing awards are open to current college students and to high school students in Wayne, Holmes, and Medina counties and in parts of nearby counties traditionally served by Wayne College.

High school and college students may submit work in the **Poetry** category (up to 3 poems, limit of 50 lines per poem), in the **Short Story** category (one story, limit of 2,000 words), and/or in the **Personal Essay** category (one essay, limit of 2,000 words).

There will be up to three awards in each category:

## FORMATTING REQUIREMENTS

- All entries must be typed.

### • Poetry

- Student name and address in upper right corner
- Single spaced
- 50 line limit per poem

### • Short Stories

- Double spaced
- Title page should have the following:
  - Title
  - Author's name, address, telephone
  - School, grade/year & instructor
  - Date
- First page after the title page should be numbered as page 1
- Subsequent pages should be numbered consecutively at the right top
- Staple all pages together in the upper left corner
- 2,000 word limit

### • Personal Essay

- Double spaced
- Title page should have the following:
  - Title
  - Author's name, address, telephone
  - Date
- First page after the title page should be numbered as page 1
- Subsequent pages should be numbered consecutively at the right top
- Staple all pages together in the upper left corner
- 2,000 word limit
